Course Purpose:

This course is designed to teach basic and advanced photographic techniques that are required to document crime scenes and accident scenes for investigative purposes and court presentation. The following topics will be covered:

- Functions and controls of digital single-lens-reflex (DSLR) cameras and other types of digital cameras
- Understanding depth of field and motion control
- Close-up photography
- Functions and controls of detachable flash units
- Solving lighting problems using fill-flash, painting with light, menu selections
- Interior and exterior crime scene and accident scene documentation
- Photographing victims and suspects
- Considerations for managing digital images

This course will be approximately 50% lecture and 50% hands-on practical application. **There will be evening classes on Tuesday, July 28, 2009.** Attendees are encouraged to dress professionally but comfortably.

About the Instructors:

Kerri McClary received her Bachelor of Arts degree in Criminal Justice from Central State University in Oklahoma.
